Fee Schedule and Payment Plan

Fee Schedule

Course fees consist of three elements as outlined below;

1. Administration Enrolment Fees

This fee covers student enrolment administration.

- All qualifications (training and assessment) incur a non-refundable enrolment fee of \$550 (GST Inc.) which is required to be paid to confirm the enrolment process.
- Enrolments in Skill Sets (training and assessment) incur a non-refundable enrolment fee of \$275 (GST Inc.) which is required to be paid to confirm the enrolment process.
- Enrolment for stand-alone units of competency (training and assessment and) incurs a non-refundable enrolment fee of \$132 (GST Inc.) which is required to be paid to confirm the enrolment process.
- All RPL applications incur a non-refundable enrolment fee of \$242 (GST Inc.) which is required to be paid to confirm the enrolment process.

2. Tuition Fees

Tuition fees cover training and assessment including facilities and learning materials used during theory and practical sessions and are GST free.

Travel/Accommodation and Personal Protective Equipment Costs

The Certificate III program is delivered across several locations in SA to experience different beekeeping operations and practices. Students need to be aware of the additional cost for transport and accommodation that this will require and is the responsibility of the student to organise and cover.

Students will need to purchase individual beekeeping PPE in order to undertake the practical sessions. These can be purchased from any beekeeping supplier. Equipment requirements are outlined in the student handbook. Further advice will be provided on enrolment prior to the need to purchase equipment.

Payment Plan
